- Homeschool students may attend field trips if they are enrolled in the class going on the trip.
- Activities outside of AM session hours such as class parties, may not be available and is left to the discretion of the classroom teacher.
- Schoolwide events such as the Spiritual Emphasis Retreat are available to homeschool students for an additional fee.
- Elementary students may participate in Christmas and Spring music concerts if enrolled in Music class.

Elementary (K-5)

Middle School (6-8)

Pre-Algebra, Algebra I, Science, Social Studies, Bible, Language Arts, Writing Lab, Middle School Chorale, Concert Band, and P.E.

High School (9-12)

Bible: Biblical Studies I,II,III, IV, Biblical Leadership

Social Studies: World History, American History I & II, Government & Economics, AP Psychology

English: English I, II, III, IV, AP Language/Composition, AP English Literature

Science: Physical Science, Biology, Biology II, Chemistry, Anatomy & Physiology, Physics, Marine Science

Math: Consumer Math, Algebra I & II, Geometry, Statistics, Pre-Calculus, AP Calculus

World Languages: Spanish I, II, III

Electives: High School Chorale, Concert Band, Praise & Worship Ensemble, P.E.



Homeschool students may take a maximum of 20 credits per year. Students exceeding 20 credits must enroll as a full-time student.

Athletic Competition

Homeschool students may participate on ACS athletic teams if enrolled in grades 6-12, taking 5 or more credits including one core academic course **for the duration of the entire school year**, and team space allows. Regular athletic fees apply.

All courses required by the State of NJ for graduation must be satisfactorily completed for a homeschool student to receive a diploma from ACS. A homeschool student must complete a minimum of 40 credits at ACS over their high school career to receive a diploma from ACS and participate in graduation.

Only home school students who have been enrolled as full-time students for their junior and senior years (two consecutive) years will be ranked within their class and be recognized for awards and scholarships.
