

Transportation Information 2022-2023 School Year

For ABSECON residents

Fill out the B6T Form and return to the ACS School Office yearly.

Absecon School District will follow up with you on bus transportation.

For EGG HARBOR TOWNSHIP Residents

Fill out the B6T Form and return to the ACS School Office yearly.

Make an appointment to go to the EHT School Transportation Department with student's birth certificate and 2 forms proving residency (utility bill, mortgage, driver's license, etc.)

K-8th Grade Students Living in EHT: If you <u>live less than 2 miles from ACS</u>, your student is not eligible for Aid in Lieu of Transportation, according to New Jersey State Statute. EHT is not providing a bus.

9th-12th Grade Students Living in EHT: If you <u>live less than 2.5 miles</u> from ACS, your student is not eligible for Aid in Lieu of Transportation, according to New Jersey State Statute. EHT is not providing a bus.

K-8th Grade Students in EHT who live from 2 to 20 miles away from school or 9th-12th grade students who live from 2.5 to 20 miles from school – The Egg Harbor Township School District will send you a form B7T to fill out during the first semester of school. Fill out and return to them ASAP. You are eligible for \$1,022 Aid in Lieu of Transportation for each child in K-12th grade. The EHT School District will send you a check for half of the amount after the first semester and half after the second semester. This check will come from your school district, not ACS.

For OCEAN CITY Residents

Fill out the B6T Form and return to ACS School Office yearly.

Go to the Ocean City School Transportation Department with your student's birth certificate and 2 forms proving residency (utility bill, mortgage, driver's license, etc.)

The School District will send bus passes before the first day of school.

For PLEASANTVILLE residents

Fill out B6T and B7T forms and return to the ACS School Office yearly.

You are eligible for \$1,022 Aid in Lieu of Transportation for each child in K-12th grade.

The Pleasantville School District will send you a check for half of the amount after the first semester (usually in January) and half after the second semester (usually in June). This check will come from your school district, not ACS.

For OTHER SCHOOL DISTRICTS

Fill out the B6T Form and return to ACS Office yearly.

If you Live Within 20 Miles of ACS -- Your Local School District will send you a form B7T to fill out during the first semester of school. Fill out and return to them ASAP.

You are eligible for \$1,022 Aid in Lieu of Transportation for each child in K-12th grade.

Your School District will send you a check for half of the amount after the first semester (usually in January) and half after the second semester (usually in June). This check will come from your school district, not ACS.
