NEW ACS INTENSIVE CONCENTRATION PROGRAMS

These programs will be offered to sophomores, juniors and seniors right here on the ACS campus for the entire day on Wednesdays. Students in this program need to understand that all work missed during the regularly scheduled classes will need to be made up. In place of the concentration classes, students will be placed in a study hall to make up the work missed.

CULINARY

Culinary Arts prepares students for a variety of occupations in the hospitality and food service industries. First year students learn food preparation, sanitation and safety, nutrition, basic baking, dining room service, menu planning, purchasing, receiving, inventory, and storage, human relations, sustainability, and nutrition in an industry standard kitchen. Students have the opportunity to showcase these skills though several catering events within the school and community. Second year students continue to advance their competencies in food preparation, sanitation and safety, nutrition, and basic baking.

ATLANTIC

SOUND ENGINEERING & TECHNICIAN

This program will provide the students with the tools to be able to set up, break down, and run a full stage performance. Concepts covered include basic stage electronics and acoustic principles, waveform properties, microphone concepts and placement techniques, stage set up and signal flow, console theory, signal processing concepts, multi-track principles and operation, and an overview of mixing.

CHRISTIAN SCHOOL PATHS PROGRAMS

These programs will be offered to sophomores, juniors, and seniors at the Bethel campus of The Pilgrim Academy. Students would need to be dropped off and picked up at the Bethel Campus on Wednesdays. Drop off by 9am and pickup at 3pm (there is some flexibility in the drop off and pick up depending on the students/parents needs) Students in this program need to understand that all work missed during the regularly scheduled classes will need to be made up. In place of the concentration classes, students will be placed in a study to make up the work missed and complete concentration assignments.

CONSTRUCTION

Offered through a partnership with The PATHS program held at the Bethel campus of The Pilgrim Academy. Students will learn to work with wood to build and repair structures and other items. They will learn to calculate quotes, how to meet with clients, and design plans for remodeling projects. Selection and sourcing of appropriate materials, negotiating with suppliers, and working with other specialists on construction projects will be taught.

AUTOMOTIVE TECHNICIAN

Offered through a partnership with The PATHS program held at the Bethel campus of The Pilgrim Academy. Students will learn extensive vehicle diagnostic and repair skills. Students will demonstrate knowledge of sophisticated diagnostic tools to improve engine performance and repair transmissions, steering, and suspension, brake, electrical, heating, and air conditioning systems. In addition to mechanical skills, excellent customer service skills will be covered, as these are imperative to explain repairs and suggest preventative maintenance to clients.
